Our law clerks work directly with staff attorneys providing research, writing, and litigation support across a broad spectrum of labor and employment matters, with a focus on NYS Education Law. Our goal is to provide law students with the opportunity to assist staff attorneys with representation of our members and local unions in a variety of matters, including disciplinary proceedings, arbitrations, federal and state litigation, and proceedings before agencies such as the Public Employment Relations Board and the National Labor Relations Board. We make a concerted effort to provide our law clerks with opportunities to attend proceedings and meetings to be exposed to the "real life" practice of a union-side attorney.

Law clerks earn \$22.00/hour, with the expectation that they will work 12-15 hours per week. **This is a fully remote position with a New York State residency requirement.** We are looking for hard working students with a demonstrated interest in the labor movement and the rights of working people.
